What should you know?

Fresno Adventist Academy utilizes the Apple iPad for textbooks. *LAPTOPS ARE NOT PERMITTED*. During the school year, iPads will be erased, managed and monitored by FAA. Furthermore, there will be no access to any iCloud accounts. iPads are to be used for academics only. Please save all pictures, data, documents, etc. prior to dropping off your iPad. At the end of the school year, students need to email, air drop, and/or transfer any data they wish to save before iPad is erased for summer break. FAA will reset iPads to the default setting for students to use as desired at the end of the school year. Students and families agree to only use the iPad as an educational tool and are aware of the restrictions FAA installs.

BYOD Equipment Program (Laptops are not permitted, please keep them at home)

Students are required to BYOD (Bring your own device). The following specifications are a baseline requirement.

Approved iPad models with minimum 32 Gb of storage AND IOS 17 or greater:

- iPad
- iPad Air
- iPad Pro
- NO IPAD MINIS

FAA iPad System Management (MDM)

Fresno Adventist Academy is utilizing a management system (MDM) for the iPad Textbook Program. The management system will monitor, manage and provide technical support for the iPads. Our goal is to ensure that the iPads remain an academic tool used specifically for that purpose on our campus. To enroll the iPads into the MDM there is an \$89 fee included in the iPad program. *If an iPad is lost, stolen or damaged, an additional \$89 set up fee will be charged to reactivate.* Find my iPad will also be enabled by default to assist in locating an iPad. (Find my iPad is limited to Wi-Fi and requires the iPad to be enabled and connected to a wireless network.)





iPad Preparation

Prior to dropping off your student(s) iPad to be programmed with the management system, please ensure the following has been performed:

- 1. Backup all personal data. Once the iPad is submitted to FAA all data will be erased.
- 2. Perform a factory restore and update on your iPad. (See below instructions on erasing all content and settings from the iPad.)

Erase your iPad and restore it to factory setting

- 1. Go to settings > General > Reset, then tap Erase all Contents and Settings
- 2. Enter your passcode or Apple ID password
- 3. Confirm that you want to erase your device
- 4. Wait for all content to be safely removed from your device

If iPad is not completely reset, there will be a delay in getting your iPad back.
